September is Suicide Awareness Month

Suicide is the 2nd leading cause of death for people ages 10-34 and the 4th leading cause of death for people 35-54. The overall suicide rate in the U.S. has increased by 31% since 2001. When someone says he or she is thinking about suicide, or says things that sound as if the person is considering suicide, it can be very upsetting. You may not be sure what to do to help, whether you should take talk of suicide seriously, or if your intervention might make the situation worse. Taking action is always the best choice. Here's what to do.

5 Things You Should Know About Preventing Suicide

1. Everyone can help prevent suicide.
2. Know the warning signs of suicide.
3. Ask questions.
4. If someone is in crisis, stay with them and get help.
5. Suicide prevention resources are available.

Septiembre es el Mes de Concientización sobre el Suicidio

El suicidio es la segunda causa principal de muerte entre las personas de 10 a 34 años y la cuarta causa principal de muerte entre las personas de 35 a 54 años. La tasa general de suicidios en los EE. UU. ha aumentado un 31% desde 2001.

Cuando alguien dice que está pensando en suicidarse, o dice cosas que suenan como si la persona estuviera pensando en suicidarse, puede ser muy difícil. Es posible que no esté seguro de qué hacer para ayudar, si debe tomarse en serio hablar de suicidio o si su intervención podría empeorar la situación. Tomar acción es siempre la mejor opción. Esto es lo que debe hacer.

5 cosas que debe saber sobre la prevención del suicidio

1. Todos pueden ayudar a prevenir el suicidio.
2. Conozca las señales de advertencia del suicidio.
3. Haz preguntas.
4. Si alguien está en crisis, quédese con ellos y obtenga ayuda.
5. Hay recursos disponibles para la prevención del suicidio.

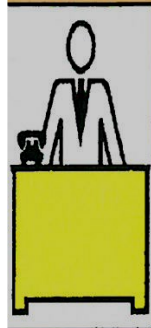
