St. Francis has been reunited with one of its members who was killed in World War II and is buried in the Netherlands – a connection that involves a curious Dutchman and volunteer helpers in Florida and Oak Creek.

Bart van der Sterren of Schinveld, the Netherlands, says people in his country adopt graves of American soldiers as a fervent way of honoring their Liberators. This is a practice handed down generation to generation.

He adopted the grave of Pfc. Hans Bergmayr of the 49th Infantry Battalion in the 8th Armored Division, who was killed on Feb. 26, 1945, and is buried in the Netherlands American Cemetery near Margraten. Bergmayr stepped on a mine 25 yards from van der Sterren's hometown of Posterholt, the Dutchman's research found.

Grave adopters bring flowers for Liberation Day, Dutch Memorial Day, etc.

With the help of Volunteers Laura Phillips of Inverness, Florida, and Tom Mueller of Oak Creek, van der Sterren found that Bergmayr's original church was St. Francis

St. Francis lost 13 men in World War II, These men are buried overseas:

– **Army Pfc. Hans Bergmayr**,
Killed Feb 26, 1945, buried at Margraten, Netherlands

– **Army Pvt. Bruno Schwartz**,
killed Nov. 6, 1943, buried at Nettuno, Italy.

– **Army Sgt. Charles Endrizzi**,
killed Aug. 15, 1944, buried at St. James, France.

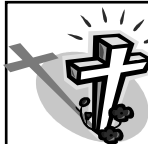
– **Army Pfc. Nicholas Schumacher**,
killed Nov. 16, 1945, buried at St. Avold, France.

– **Navy Aviation Machinist's Mate 2nd Class Mirko Tomac**, declared MIA May 11, 1945, on the MIA wall in Honolulu, Hawaii. Naval custom was to declare someone MIA one year and one day after they first were missing.

– **Army Air Forces Staff Sgt. Norman Zinda**, killed on Sept. 9, 1943, buried in the Philippines.

We remember these brave men and all those who have given their lives for our freedom.
