The State Budget is a Moral Document Take Action!
Contact the Governor and your Representatives TODAY

"Speak out for those who cannot speak . . . defend the rights of the poor and needy." -- Proverbs 31:8-9

The budget includes many measures that will have serious impacts on the most vulnerable residents in our state in the next two years and beyond.

Those of greatest concern include: **Reducing the Earned Income Tax Credit** by \$56 million, **increasing taxes** for 152,000 low-wage working families with children; Ending inflation adjustment for the **Homestead Tax Credit**, costing low-income households \$13.6 million; **Cutting** about \$500 million in state general purpose revenue from **Medicaid**, including \$111 from **Family Care**, which provides flexible options in long-term care for the elderly and people with disabilities; **Elimination of Foodshare** for qualified legal immigrants who have been in the U.S. less than 5 years.

Let the Governor and your representatives know that, as a people of faith, we understand the budget as a moral document. We are deeply concerned about the values it embodies and how it will affect those with the least power and prestige among us.

Our concern will not end when it is signed into law. Our engagement with the legislative process will continue as its consequences are felt in the coming months and years. We are committed to being voices for those whose voices are seldom heard in our Capitol.
